Dear Competitors & Coaches

This year we have received a record entry for our regatta – for which please accept our sincere thanks. Without your continuing support we could not run the event.

Unfortunately, this record entry has coincided with a particularly unfavourable tide condition which we have to work around: This, and the fact that of the 50 events we are running only three have no doubling up or equipment sharing issues to consider, means the timetabling has been particularly difficult this year. Please allow plenty of time to get boated in what will for a while in the afternoon be a very congested boating area.
